WINE

LOESS INSPIRATION was born out of a blending session while creating the final blend for **LOESS** Crianza 2012. During a moment of **INSPIRATION**, a new wine appeared that would fit perfectly in the **LOESS** range as a younger wine.

Harvest: Harvested by hand in October. This is an ideal time in Ribera del Duero. That way, grapes ripen slowly with good acidity.

Yields: The yields per hectare range between 2,800 Kg and 4,600 Kg.

Barrel Ageing: The different components that make up this wine have been aged on average for 9 months in premium French oak with different toasts. The barrels are 1st, 2nd and 3rd use.

Production: about 35,000 bottles.

Varietal: 100% Tempranillo.

Region: Ribera del Duero.

Vineyards: Loess own Vineyards.

Alcohol: 14,5% alc.

TASTING NOTES

Fruit forward, intense with abundant notes of red and wild black berry fruits. Delicate hints of oak, lead to an elegant, juicy and long silky finish.

The wine has been bottled on the 8th September 2014. 23,600 bottles.

LOESS is a range of small production wines based on the philosophy that great wines are born in exceptional vineyards. Today, **LOESS** owns 6 extraordinary vineyards planted in different soils that offer different expressions of the magnificent Ribera del Duero region.
